

VEHICLE RESCUE IN THE NEW MILLENNIUM

Our newly revised “Vehicle Rescue in the New Millennium” course covers all of the requirements set forth in NFPA 1670 Chapter 8 for Vehicle and Machinery Rescue. (Awareness, Operations, and Technician levels) It also covers new vehicle designs and materials, along with safety and extrication procedures for working with hybrid and alternative fuels vehicles. Mitigating hazards at late model vehicle fires will also be covered.

All attendees will receive an Instructors Manual, PowerPoint presentations and training videos on DVD, along with a certificate from Scene Of The Accident as a Vehicle Rescue Instructor. Each participant will also become a member of our Accident Scene Safety Trainers Network and receive access to the Instructor Resources section of our website, which contains course updates along with all of our new courses as soon as they are available for no additional cost. All participants will be able to use our materials to train other members of their departments when they return from class. Our goal is NOT to replace your current training program, only to update and enhance it.

This 2-day event features 1 day of classroom training and 1 day of hands-on extrication training. The hands-on day of training affords all participants the opportunity to practice the new procedures learned in the classroom session to overcome the new and additional challenges faced with today’s high-tech vehicles. Attendees can choose to participate in the hands-on evolutions or use this time to take pictures and video.
